**Sprint:-** In athletics and track and field, sprints are races over short distances.

Shot put:-An throwing to throw a spherical object as far as possible



Hurdels:-The <u>sprint hurdles</u> at the <u>Summer</u> <u>Olympics</u> have been contested over a variety of distances at the <u>multi-sport event</u>. The men's <u>110</u> metres hurdles has been present on the Olympic athletics programme since the first edition in <u>1896</u>. A men's <u>200 metres hurdles</u> was also briefly held, from 1900 to 1904. The first won en's sprint hurdling event was added to the programme at the **<u>1932 Olympics</u>** in the form of the <u>80</u> meteres hurdles. At the 1972 Games the women's distance was extended to the **100 metres hurdles**, which is the current international standard.





☐ High Jump:-The high jump is a <u>track and field</u> event in which competitors must jump unaided over a horizontal bar placed at measured heights without dislodging it





Long Jump:-The long jump is a track and field event in which athletes combine speed, strength and agility in an attempt to leap as far as possible from a take off point. Along with the triple jump, the two events that measure jumping for distance as a group are referred to as the "horizontal jumps".





Hammer throw: - The hammer throw is one of the four throwing events in regular track and field competitions, along with the discus throw, shot put and javelin. The "hammer" used in this sport is not like any of the tools also called by that name. It consists of a metal ball attached by a steel wire to a grip. The size of the ball varies between men's and women's competitions

Triple Jump:-The triple jump, sometimes referred to as the **hop**, **step and jump** or the **hop**, skip and jump, is a track and field event, similar to the long jump. As a group, the two events are referred to as the "horizontal jumps". The competitor runs down the track and performs a hop, a bound and then a jump into the sand pit. The triple jump was inspired by the <u>ancient</u> Olympic Games and has been a modern **Olympics** event since the Games' inception in





**Relay:**-A **relay** race is a track and field event in which **athletes** run a pre-set distance carrying a baton before passing it onto the next runner. Often, a **relay** team is a team of four sprinters. In **athletics**, the two standard **relays** are the 4x100 meter **relay** and the 4x400 meter **relay**.
